

UL Wolves driver's policy and procedures

- Daily check and Defect Book (small book found in vehicle folder) to be filled in each time you use the vehicle.
- Report any Defects to Jana or Lisa as soon as you notice it. Take pictures if necessary.
- If you cause any damage, report it to Jana/Lisa immediately. The Club or Society will then pay for the damage done. Not reporting it will result in suspension of vehicle usage.
- If you don't show up to collect the keys when you have a booking, or return the keys late with no notification to Jana or Lisa, your next booking will be cancelled.
- Individuals may be suspended from vehicle use for speeding violations, use of a mobile phone while driving, failure to refuel the vehicle upon return, or returning the vehicle in an unclean condition.
- Drivers are advised, and all occupants should be made aware, that vehicles may be
 equipped with CCTV cameras for the safety and protection of all users. For more
 information on how video images are captured and used, please see the Privacy
 Notice attached below.
- All C&S vehicles are equipped with eFlow toll tags. When a club or society uses a
 vehicle, any toll charges will be temporarily covered by the C&S card. However,
 these charges must be reimbursed to the C&S card within one week. Failure to pay
 will result in future vehicle bookings being cancelled until paid.
- All bookings are subject to cancellation if any of the policies are broken or if the vehicle needs to undergo work.

Privacy Notice: CCTV Cameras in Student Life Vehicles

Student Life vehicles are equipped with CCTV cameras for the protection and safety of all occupants. The cameras record both the interior and exterior of the vehicle.

Purpose of Recording:

- To enhance the safety and security of passengers and drivers.
- To provide evidence in case of incidents or emergencies.

Data Collected:

 Video footage of the vehicle's interior and exterior, which may include images of occupants.

Legal Basis for Processing:

 The processing of this data is based on our legitimate interest in ensuring safety and security, and for insurance purposes

Data Retention:

 Recorded footage will be retained for a maximum of 30 days and will be deleted thereafter unless required for ongoing investigations.

Access to Data:

Access to recorded footage is restricted to authorized personnel only.
 Footage may be shared with law enforcement if necessary for investigations.

Your Rights:

- You have the right to request access to the footage recorded during your time in the vehicle.
